Semmes, of the Navy, volunteer aid-decamp, the most cordial thanks of the General of the division are tendered, for his uniform gallantry and assistance, and the General-in-chief is requested to present the conduct of this accomplished and gallant officer to the special notice of the chief of his distinguished branch of the public service, our glorious navy"—Therefore,

Be it resolved by the General Assembly of Mary land, That the thanks and congratulations of the Legislature of his native State are hereby tendered to Lieut. Semmes, for his gallant conduct during the present war with Mexico, and we cordially recommend him to the favorable consideration of the Executive of our National Government for promotion.
