CHANCELLOR—Upon its being made appear to, in proof, in a proper suit to be instituted in the court of chancery, &c., that it will be for the benefit, &c., of all parties interested, that the property mentioned in a sale from Mary Tyson, to George Gibson, in trust dated 29th, August 1837, and recorded in land records of Baltimore county to decree a sale, &c., 132

To order proceeds of sale to be invested, under and subject to same trusts, set out in same deed, in any investment in this State or Louisiana, &c.,
