INSOLVENT LAWS—

now required by the revenue laws, etc., before the expiration of the term to which applicant is bound to appear, etc. 242

Any applicant for the benefit of the, seized of any lands, etc., at the time of his application and shall refuse to deliver possession, etc., to trustees, etc. county court upon petition, etc., of trustees etc., to pass an order, etc., commanding said insolvent to shew cause within fifteen days why writ of *habere facias possessionem* shall not be issued, setting up a copy of publication on the premises ten days before the time fixed for answering to be sufficient service, etc.

On failure of insolvent, etc., to answer or having answered failing to shew satisfactory cause why said writ should not be issued, court to issue writ of *habere facias possessionem* directed to the sheriff, etc., to deliver possession to purchaser, etc., where sold, etc.

This law to apply to all casses where insolvent was seized of any land, etc., or when entitled to any equity of redemption, etc.

INSPECTION OF LUMBER—A supplement to the act of 1845, chapter 171, relating to, at Bristol, Clagetts Landing, Mount Calvert, Green Landing and Wapping, etc.

INSPECTOR AND WOOD CORDER—Governor to appoint every second year one, at Clarksville, etc.

INSPECTORS OF FLOUR—The Governor with consent of the Senate to appoint biennially one assistant flour inspector for Baltimore in addition, etc., subject to rules now applicable, etc., to receive compensation in like manner, etc.

INSPECTORS OF TOBACCO—See *Tobacco Growers.*

INSURANCE COMPANIES—See *Mutual Insurance Company of Allegany county; Mutual Insurance Company of Wash-*
