86. An act to allow John R. Baden, former sheriff of Prince George's county, further time to complete his collections.

87. An act for the relief of the Baltimore and Harford Turnpike Company.

88. An act to incorporate the Howard Street Savings Bank.

89. An act to allow Washington Finley, former collector of taxes for Queen Anne's county, further time to complete his collections.

90. An act to divorce Jehu Brown from Elizabeth his wife.
