

or, and shall be liable to presentment and indictment by the grand jury of said county, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined a sum not less than fifty, nor more than two hundred dollars and costs, the said fines to be paid over to the successors in office of said trustees, to be by them applied to the use of the school fund of their primary school district. CHAP. 74.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That all suits hereafter to be brought against delinquent trustees, under the provisions of the said act of December session, eighteen hundred and forty-five, chapter one hundred and fifty-four, shall stand for trial and judgment at the first term; *provided*, process be served on the defendant at least ten days before the beginning of the term, unless good cause of continuance be shewn, and that the defendant shall not be entitled to a stay of execution upon judgment rendered in any such suit; *provided however*, that he shall be entitled to supersede the same within sixty days after its rendition, for six months, to be computed from the date of the judgment, in the manner now provided by law. Suits to stand for trial at first term.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That all such parts of any acts of assembly now in force, so far as they are inconsistent with the provisions of this act, be and the same are hereby repealed. Provisoes.

CHAPTER 74.

*An act to make valid certain proceedings of the trustees of the New Jerusalem Church in Baltimore.* Inconsistent acts repealed.

Passed Feb. 11. 1845.

WHEREAS, it is represented to this General Assembly, by the petition of the trustees of the New Jerusalem Church in Baltimore, that for the purpose of constituting a corporation in pursuance of the provisions of the act of the General Assembly, passed at November session, eighteen hundred and two, chapter one hundred and eleven, entitled, an act to incorporate certain persons in every Christian church or congregation in this State, the Christian society or congregation in the city of Baltimore, known by the name of the New Jerusalem Church did, in the year eighteen hundred and four, elect trustees, and fix upon their plan, agreement or constitution which, duly acknowledged and recorded in the office of the clerk of Baltimore county as required by
