

CHAP. 106. SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the said commissioners, or a majority of them, shall value and ascertain the damage that may be sustained by any person or persons through whose land the said road may be made to pass, taking into consideration the advantages and disadvantages, if any, and the damages so ascertained shall be levied and assessed as any other county charges in said county.

Qualification. SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the said commissioners before they proceed to act, shall take an oath or affirmation before some justice of the peace, that they will, without favor, partiality or prejudice, assess the damages sustained by the person or persons through whose land the said road may pass.

Inconsistent acts repealed. SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That all acts or parts of acts, inconsistent with the provisions of this act, be and the same are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 106.

Passed Jan. 21, 1848. *An act to allow Edward S. L. Young, former collector of the State and county taxes of Caroline county, further time to complete his collections.*

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Edward S. L. Young, former collector of the State and county taxes of Caroline county, be and he is hereby authorised and empowered to collect any taxes or balance of taxes now remaining due to and uncollected by him in the county aforesaid, in the same manner and with the same power and privileges as are allowed by existing laws in said cases made and provided.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall remain in full force until the first day of February, eighteen hundred and fifty, and no longer.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the expenses of surveying and opening said road shall be levied and paid by the commissioners of Anne Arundel county, as other county charges are levied and paid, upon receiving from said commissioners an account on oath of the said expenses, including an allowance of two dollars per day for the commissioners appointed by this act, and the said money not exceeding one hundred dollars.

An act to allow in Carroll county.
