## CHAPTER 115. 2200 bas aved onap. 116.

An act entitled, an act to make valid a deed from Da-Passed Feb. 22, 1850. vid McKinzie and wife to John Dabbs.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a deed dated the tenth day of June, in the year valid. eighteen hundred and forty-five, from David McKinzie and wife to John Dabbs, be and the same is hereby declared to be as valid and available in law, for all intents and purposes, as if the same had been stamped as required by law; provided, that the duty chargeable by Proviso law, on said deed shall be paid to the clerk of the court of Howard District, of Anne Arundel county, within one month after the passage of this act.

## CHAPTER 116.

An act to incorporate the Trustees of the Parsonage Feb. 22, 1850. of Annamessex Circuit of Somerset County.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the authority of the Methodist Episcopal Church, in the said Annamessex Circuit, shall have full power to appoint, from time to P time, the successors to the above named corporators, and the successors appointed by such authority, shall
