SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the said body corporate shall be authorised to hold real and personal estate to the value of five thousand dollars, for the use of the said Methodist Episcopal Church, in the said Annapessex Circuit, as a parsonage, and that all deeds and conveyances of real estate to them heretofore made, be valid, and that the property conveyed to them by the same, be vested in the said corporation for the uses and purposes above expressed.

*An act for the relief of Patrick Tormey, of Frederick County.*

Preamble.

WHEREAS, Patrick Tormey, an applicant for the benefit of the insolvent laws of this State, has represented to the General Assembly of Maryland, that in making out the papers and proceedings under his aforesaid application, in Frederick county court, during its session of November, eighteen hundred and forty-nine, certain inaccuracies and errors were inadvertently made, which may deprive him of the benefit of said application—Therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the said Patrick Tormey shall not be deprived of his final discharge, under said application, by reason of any such errors and informalities;

Proviso.

*provided however,* that this act shall not be construed so as to deprive his creditors of their right to file allegations, or of any other of their general privileges now existing under the insolvent laws of this State; but that the same shall be construed simply to make valid the said application, and the proceedings had thereunder, and to place the said applicant in the same position which he would have occupied under and by virtue of the provisions of the insolvent laws aforesaid, if the said errors and informalities had not been committed as aforesaid.
