Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Orphans court of Maryland, That the justices of the orphans court to pass order of Frederick county, be and they are hereby authorised, empowered, and directed, to pass an older for the payment to the trustees of the alms house of Frederick county, the said sum of forty-four dollars and thirty-five cents, and the interest thereon accrued, deposited in the Fredericktown Savings Institution, for the use of the said Leo Sowers, in the name of the register of wills of Frederick county, and subject to their order, to be applied by the said trustees of the alms house of Frederick county, to the support and maintenance of the said Leo Sowers.
