### CHAPTER 178.

Passed Feb 28 1850. *An act to repeal an act passed at December Session, eighteen hundred and forty-three, chapter three hundred and thirty-one.*

Repealed. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the act passed at December Session, eighteen hundred and forty-three, chapter three hundred and thirty-one, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Revived. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the act regulating the itinerant charges of the members of the General Assembly of Maryland, and which was repealed by the aforesaid act of eighteen hundred and forty-three, chapter three hundred and thirty-one, be and the same is hereby re-enacted and revived.

In force. SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the commencement of present session.

### CHAPTER 179.

Passed March 1, 1850. *A supplement to an act entitled, an act to incorporate the Baltimore and Liberty Turnpike Road Company.*

Repealed] SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the first section of an act entitled, an act to incorporate the Baltimore and Liberty Turnpike Road Company, passed at December Session, eighteen hundred and forty-three, in so far as the same fixes the place of beginning, and defines the extent of the said turnpike road, be and the same is hereby repealed, and instead thereof, that the said
