by a carriage of slower draught, keep their horses and CHAP. 197. carriages on the right hand of the said road, in the passing direction, leaving the other side of the road free and smalles well clear for other carriages to pass and re-pass; and if any driver shall offend against this provision, he shall forfeit and pay not exceeding ten dollars, to any person who shall be obstructed in his passage, and will warrant for the same, to be recovered, with cost, before any justice, sallos lo viad in the same manner as debts under ten pounds are recovered.

SEC. 20. And be it enacted, That the said president and managers of the said plank or turnpike road, for May farm out the time being, shall and may, and they are hereby road authorised and empowered to grant, demise, and farm, let, to any person or persons with whom they can again to the agree, the tolls and duties which they, by virtue of this act, or their own bye-laws, are authorised to demand and receive for passage in, upon, and along the said road, at any such gate or turnpike over or upon the same, or any part of the same, for any term not exceeding seven years, under such rents, reservations and conditions, as the said president and managers, at any meeting of their board shall agree upon, which grants and demises shall have the constructions, force and effect as other like grants and demises may, between private persons, have and receive.

SEC. 21. And be it enacted, That the Liberty and Banking forbid Franklin Plank or Turnpike Road Company shall not issue any scrip, token, device, or other evidence of debt, to be used as currency.

SEC. 22. And be it enacted, That the Legislature re-Reservation. serves to itself the right to alter, change or abolish this act at pleasure.
