A supplement to the act entitled, an act relating to Passed Jan. Femes Covert.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That any free white female, born without the limits rights, &c. or jurisdiction of the United States, who hath intermarried, or shall intermarry with a citizen of the United States, and doth or shall actually reside therein after such intermarriage, such female shall have and enjoy within this State all the immunities, rights and privileges of a native born citizen, so far as to enable such female to become an executrix, or administratrix;
