CHAPTER 203.

An act authorising the sale of a certain Public House, Passed in Worcester County. Passed Feb. 26, 1850

Authority to

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That James M. Holland, Jacob Payne, John S. Jones, John W. Jones, and William Payton, or any three of them, be and they are hereby authorised and empowered, after they shall have given at least ten days notice thereof, set up in writing at the door of each store house in the village of Sandy Hill, sell and dispose of in any way they may deem proper, a certain house situated near said village, sometimes called the Union school house, or old school house, and apply the money for which the same may be sold to the repairing of the public shool house at or near said village owned by the commissioners of said county, at any time and in such manner as the trustees in that school district may deem advisable.
