SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Construction of Maryland, That every last will and testament, exe-wills cuted in due form of law, after the first day of June and stand next, shall be construed with reference to the real ago ad or too estate and personal estate comprised in it, to speak and take effect as if it had been executed on the day of the death of the testator or testatrix, unless a contrary intention shall appear by the will.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the provisions of Exceptions this act shall not apply to any will executed before the passage of this act, by any person who may die before the first day of June next unless in such will the intention of the testator or testatrix shall appear that the real and personal estate which he or she may own at his or her death, should thereby pass.
