Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Name changed That the name of the Pleasant Valley Union Band, of Washington county, be and the same is hereby changed to the name of the Mechanics Band, of Rohersville, and by that name shall enjoy all the privileges and be subjected to all the responsibilities provided for in the act to which this is a supplement.
