And be it enacted, That the said commis- Election dissioners of primary schools shall be, and they are here tricts to be diby vested with authority to divide each election dis-school districts trict of said county into as many school districts as in their judgment they may deem expedient or necessary for the convenience of the inhabitants thereof.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That the said commission of the sioners of primary schools, and their successors, in Carroll county, shall apportion the said school fund, and every other fund, including the academy fund, belonging to the primary schools in said county, among the several districts of said county, according to the number of children in attendance upon said schools.

SEC. 7. And be it enacted, That the legal voters of Voters to elect each school district shall elect, by ballot, annually, on three trustees in each school district wednesday of October, three sensible and school district discreet persons, residents thereof, who shall be called trustees of primary schools for said district, whose duty it shall be to superintend and direct the management of the school in their particular and respective district, subject to the visitation and supervision of the said school commissioners.

SEC. 8. And be it enacted, That the said commissioners may, from time to time, in their discretion, powers of the prescribe the course of study to be persued in said commissioners. schools, the qualification of teachers, the books to be used, and the hours of study and recreation, and shall admit to all the privileges of said schools, not more than four pupils from each school district, without pay or charge of any kind, but all other pupils shall pay not less than one, nor more than two dollars per quarter, according to their studies, in the discretion of said commissioners, and no preceptor in said schools shall admit to said school any pupil, free of charge, without an order from the trustees for the said school district in which said application is made, and the said school commissioners may, in their discretion, order and direct an examination of the scholars to be had in their presence, at least twice in each and every year, at which the preceptors shall be present, and said commissioners, or a majority of them, are hereby authorised to appoint preceptors for said schools, and dismiss them when they deem it proper and necessary.
