SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That all discounts or loans to be made by said corporation, it shall be governed in its calculation of interest by Rowlett's tables. Calculation of interest

SEC. 8. *And be it enacted*, That the concerns of the institution hereby intended to be incorporated, shall at all times be subject to the inspection of the treasurer of Maryland, or of such other officer or agent of the State, as may be selected for that purpose, by either branch of the Legislature. Subject to inspection

SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That the capital stock of the said corporation shall not exceed the sum of one hundred and fifty thousand dollars, until an additional capital be authorised by the General Assembly. Capital stock

SEC. 10. *And be it enacted*, That the Legislature shall have, at all times, the right to alter or annul this act, and the same shall continue and be in force for thirty years from the date of its passage. Reservation

CHAPTER 314.

*An act to allow James Tilghman, former Collector of State and County Taxes, in Queen Anne's county, further time to complete his collections.* Passed Feb. 28, 1850.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That James Tilghman, former collector of State and county taxes, in Queen Anne's county, be and he is hereby authorised to collect any and all State and county taxes, or balances of taxes due to him, and now remaining uncollected for the several years in which he was collector of State and county taxes in the said county, in the same manner, and with the same privileges and powers he could or might have done within the time limited by law. Authorised to collect

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the said James Tilghman, before he proceeds to collect, under and by virtue of this act, shall make out and deliver to the person or persons from whom any taxes, or balances of taxes, may be demanded, an account of taxes or balances due from such person or persons, and shall annex an affidavit that the same is due and unpaid.
