Be it enacted by the General Assembly Authorised to of Maryland, That James Tilghman, former collector of State and county taxes, in Queen Anne's county be and he is hereby authorised to collect any and all State and county taxes, or balances of taxes due to him, and now remaining uncollected for the several years in which he was collector of State and county taxes in the said county, in the same manner, and with the same privileges and powers he could or might have done within the time limited by law.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the said James Todeliver ac-Tilghman, before he proceeds to collect, under and by virtue of this act, shall make out and deliver to the person or persons from whom any taxes, or balances of taxes, may be demanded, an account of taxes or balances due from such person or persons, and shall annex an effidavit that the same is due and unpaid.
