Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the commissioners of the cor-widened, etc poration of the town of East Newmarket, in Dorchester county, are hereby authorised and empowered to lay out and widen the several streets in said town, and to remove all obstructions and nuisances to effect such object; provided, the said commissioners shall Provisoes deem it proper so to do; and provided also, that in no case shall they have power to extend the width of anystreet to more than forty feet.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That all damages done Indemnity for the property of citizens of said town, by the opening damages and extension of said streets, shall be paid for by said corporation.
