maintenance and preservation of said Cemetery, and CHAP. 323. the ornaments and improvements which have been,

or may hereafter be added thereto.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Purchase made of Maryland, That said purchase be as valid as if the valid name of the trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church, in the city and precincts of Baltimore, had been inserted, instead of the Methodist Episcopal Church, in the city and precincts of Baltimore, in the act to which this is a supplement.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That said corporation To receive domay receive gifts and bequests for the purpose of or-nations, &c. namenting and improving said Cemetery, and may hold such personal property as may be requisite to carry out the object of this act, and that to which it

is a supplement.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That no street, lane, or Canals. &c., alley heretofore laid out, road or canal of any sort not to be openheretofore laid out, shall be opened through that part metery. of the property of said corporation appropriated to the purposes of a Gemetery; provided, nothing herein Provisoes contained shall authorise said corporation to obstruct any public street or road, lane or alley, now actually opened and used as such; and provided, this exemption be confined to the above mentioned property, bought of Lancaster Ould, Esquire. Exempted

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That the grounds dedicated to said Cemetery, so long as they shall be used from taxation. as such, shall be liable to no tax or public imposition

whatever.

Sec. 5. And be it enacted, That any person who shall wilfully destroy, mutilate, deface, injure, or re-injuring, etc move any tomb, monument, or gravestone, or other structure, placed in the Cemetery aforesaid, or any fence, railing, or other work, for the protection or ornament of any tomb, monument, or gravestone, or other structure aforesaid, or shall wilfully destroy, cut, break, or remove any tree, shrub, or plant within the limits of said Cemetery, or shall shoot or discharge any gun or other fire-arms within the said limits, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, before any justice of the peace of Baltimore county, be punished by a fine, at the discretion of the justice, of not less than five, nor more than fifty dollars.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That every lot conveyed Lots exempted in said Cemetery shall be held by the proprietor, for from execution the purpose of sepulture alone, and for none other, as real estate, and shall not be subject to attachment

Penalty for
