CHAPTER 325.

A supplement to an act entitled, an act to Incorporate March 5, 1850: the Cumberland Savings Institution.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Name changed of Maryland, That if the president and directors of the Cumberland Savings Institution shall, on or before the first Monday of July next, pass a resolution, authorised at a general meeting of its stockholders, declaring its acceptance of this act, and transmit to the Treasurer of the State a copy of said resolution, certified under the seal of said corporation, that the name of the Cumberland Savings Institution shall be and is hereby changed to that of the Cumberland Savings Bank, with power and authority, by that name, to have, exercise, hold and enjoy, use and possess, all the rights and privileges that are conferred and prescribed by the act incorporating the
