An act supplemental to the several acts relating to the Passed Mar. 6, powers and duties of the Board of Primary Education, of Worcester County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Duty of board of Maryland, That the board of primary education, of ucation Worcester county, shall as soon as practicable, after the passage of this act, lay off said county into four general divisions, or districts, in such manner as they may deem most expedient, and appoint one of their own body, for each of said divisions, whose duty it shall be to proceed to ascertain the number of white children in their respective divisions, over four years of age and under sixteen years of age, if females, and under twenty-one years of age, if males, who are, in their opinion, proper recipients of the charity school fund of said county, and report the number of all such children, together with the names of the parents and guardians of such children, to said board of primary education, on or before the second Tuesday of September, eighteen hundred and fifty, which reports, respectively, shall designate the number of all such children, together with the names of the parents and guardians of such children, in each school dis-
