CHAPTER 329.

A supplement to an act passed at December session, Passed Mar. 6,
eighteen hundred and forty-five, chapter two hundred 1850.
and forty-five, entitled, an act to authorise the com-
missioners of Harford County, to levy a sum of mo-
ney, at their discretion, to build a bridge over Win-
ter's Run, at the Ring Factory.

WHEREAS, the levy authorised by the act to which Preamble.
this is a supplement, is insufficient for the purposes of
said act—Therefore,

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, County levy
That the commissioners of Harford county, are hereby authorised.
authorised to levy on the assessable property of said
county, an additional sum not exceeding two hundred
dollars, being in all five hundred dollars, to be expend-
ed for the purposes and under the provisions of the act
to which this is a supplement.
