SEC. 14. *And be it enacted*, That all acts inconsistent with this act, be and the same are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 343.

An act to allow Christian Sheppard, agent or deputy collector of Michael L. Ross, deceased, late Collector of State Taxes, of Washington County, further time to complete his collections.

Passed March 6, 1850.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Christian Sheppard, agent or deputy collector for Michael L. Ross, deceased, late collector of the State taxes for Washington county, for the year eighteen hundred and forty-four, be and he is hereby empowered to collect all or any State taxes that may be due and owing to him, the said Michael L. Ross, late collector, at the time of his decease, and which are now in the hands of the said Christian Sheppard, for collection, in the same manner, and with the same powers, with which the said Michael L. Ross, was authorised to do whilst he was in office, and any sale or sales of real or personal property, that may be made by the said Christian Sheppard, agent and deputy collector as aforesaid, in the collection of such taxes due and owing to the said Michael L. Ross, shall be as valid as if made by the said Michael L. Ross, himself, in the time required of him by law to complete his collections; *provided however*, that the powers hereby conferred shall not continue in force longer than the first day of April, eighteen hundred and fifty-one.
