SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Measurement of Maryland, That from and after the first day of June ed for next, it shall not be lawful to sell any lime brought into said county for agricultural or other purposes, by any bushel measure of less dimensions than the Winchester bushel, containing twenty-one hundred and fifty and forty-two hundreth cubic inches, and which has not been approved and branded as required by the act of eighteen hundred and twenty-five, chapter two hundred and six.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That any person selling Forfeiture—lime not measured as aforesaid, shall forfeit and pay for how recovered each and every offence, ten dollars, and the purchaser is hereby authorised to recover any deficiency which shall be found to exist by the keeper of standard weights and measures for said county, between the measure of such seller and that required by this act, or the value thereof, in any county court of this State, or before any justice of the peace having jurisdiction thereof.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That the penalty im-How collected

posed by this act may be collected in the name of the State of Maryland, as other fines, one half to the informer, and the other to the use of the State.
