CHAPTER 59.

An act to authorize the erection of a wharf at the Prize House Landing, at the mouth of Back Creek, in Sassafras Neck, Cecil county.

Passed Feb. 2, 1850.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That John T. Veazey, John B. Hays, James Price, John V. Price, Jeremiah C. Price, James Morgan, Francis King, Thomas Price, C. H. Morgan, Thomas D. Ward, James H. Benson, William Knight, and John Wroth, or any number of the said persons, be and they are hereby authorized to erect a wharf at the Prize House Landing, at the mouth of Back Creek, in Sassafras Neck, Cecil county, of such dimensions as to enable vessels or steam boats to lay alongside thereof, and in every way, as may in their judgment suit the purposes of trade, and soforth, and the said wharf, when so erected, shall be for the use and accommodation of the neighborhood, as a public landing.
