Proviso.

To make bye- SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That this corporation shall have power to make bye-laws, and the same to alter and amend at their pleasure; provided, they do not conflict with the laws of the State of Maryland, the laws of the United States, or the laws of the Grand Division of the Sons of Temperance, of the State of Maryland.

In force, etc

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That this act of incorporation shall enure for thirty years from its passage, and that the Legislature reserves to itself the right to alter and amend this act of incorporation at pleasure.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That nothing in this act Banking forbid be construed so as to authorise the said corporation to issue any note, token, device, scrip, or other evidence of debt, to be used as a currency.

Yewell, and Mary, his wife, appended to the said deed, was not taken and certified in accordance with the laws of this State-Therefore,

Made valid

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the clerk of Queen Anne's county be and he is hereby authorised and required to record the said deed
