An act to make valid certain Devises and Bequests, in the Last Will and Testament of Thomas Mains, late of Washington County, deceased.

Preamble.

Passed Mar. 2

1850.

WHEREAS, Thomas Mains, late of Washington county, in this State, deceased, by his last will and testament, in writing, dated the fifth day of August, eighteen hundred and forty-five, and proven and admitted to record in the said county, on the twentieth day of June, eighteen hundred and forty-eight, did give and devise unto the Right Reverend Bishop of Baltimore, for the use of the Catholic church, certain lands and premises, in said will described; and did also bequeath unto the Parish Priest of his Parish, in said county, the legacy in said will mentioned, as by the said will appears; and whereas, the Most Reverend Samuel Eccleston, the Archbishop of Baltimore, hath by his memorial to this General Assembly, asked the approbation and leave of the Legislature to the vesting of said devises and legacy; which being reasonable-Therefore,
