Be it enacted by the General Assembly Commissioners of Maryland, That as soon as may be, after the passage to be appointed of this act, it shall be the duty of the levy court of Frederick county, in their discretion, to appoint two road commissioners, and the duty of the county commissoners of Washington county, in their discretion, to appoint one road commissioner, who together shall constitute a board for laying out a road from the city of Frederick to the town of Smithsburg, in Washington county.
