CHAPTER 413.

*An act to confirm the acts of the Commissioners of* Passed  
*Baltimore County, in regard to certain State Taxes.* March 8, 1850

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly* Levy made  
*of Maryland*, That the levy imposed by the commis- valid  
sioners of Baltimore county, on the assessable prop-  
erty of said county, of twenty-five cents on the hun-  
dred dollars, on the seventh day of September, eigh-  
teen hundred and forty-eight, for State taxes for the  
year eighteen hundred and forty-eight, be and the  
same is hereby ratified and confirmed, and shall have  
the same effect and operation as if the said levy had  
been imposed within the time prescribed by the act  
of eighteen hundred and forty-one, chapter twenty-  
three, and the supplements thereto.

CHAPTER 414.

*An act to condemn and lay off a lot of ground for* Passed

*Road therein mentioned.*

WHEREAS, it is represented to this General Assem- Preamble.  
bly, by the petition of sundry citizens of Saint Mary's  
county, that they suffer great inconvenience for want  
of a public landing on Patuxent river, in said county,  
at a place called Horse landing, and a public road  
thereto—Therefore.
