SEC. 13. And be it enacted, That whenever any CHAP. 427. person shall offer to pay his or her taxes, it shall be the Treasurer to what improvement they have made, and what assessaring regard to improvement they have accumulated, since the last as sessment was made, so that the same may be added to the assessment, and if the said treasurer deems it necessary, he may take the answers of said parties under oath, and any tax payer refusing to make such statement, shall be deprived of all benefits resulting from the provisions of this act.

SEC. 14. And be it enacted, That it shall be the duty Sheriff to conof the sheriff to ascertain from all the tax payers from form to laws as whom he may collect the taxes, and take a memorandum of all accumulation of assessable property of every kind, and make return of the same to the said board of commissioners, according to the existing laws, which re-

quire the present collectors to do the same.

SEC. 15. And be it enacted, That the said treasurer Oaths required and sheriff, in making their quarterly deposits with the treasurer of the State, according to the provisions of the ninth section of this act, and also in their monthly payments to the board of commissioners, shall make and sign an affidavit, in due form of law, before some justice of the peace for Howard district, which said affidavit shall state the amount paid, that the amount as stated is a true account of all the State or district taxes received by him or them for the quarter or month, as the case may be, then ending, his legal commission excepted.
