CHAPTER 461.

A further supplement to the act entitled, an act to prevent frauds upon the Revenue, in the case hereinafter mentioned, and to punish the perpetrators thereof.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of penalty for vio. Maryland, That any negro or colored person doing lating original any of the matters and things prohibited by the act act to which this is a supplement, shall, upon indictment for and conviction thereof, the first time, be punished as is prescribed by the supplement to the said act, passed at December session, in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and forty-seven, and upon indictment and conviction for a second offence, shall, at the discretion of the court, be sentenced to hard labor in the Penitentiary, for the space of three years, or sold
