CHAPTER 486.

An act to allow Joshua Anderson, Collector of State Taxes, for the Second Collection District of Anne Arundel County, further time to complete his collections, for the year eighteen hundred and forty-nine. passed March 9, 1850.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Joshua Anderson, collector of State taxes, for the second collection district of Anne Arundel county, be and he is hereby authorised and empowered to collect any tax or balances of taxes now remaining due and uncollected by him in said election district. Time allowed.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the said Joshua Anderson, shall in every instance before he shall proceed to the aforesaid collection, make affidavit before some justice of the peace for said county, that the same remains due and uncollected, and that he hath not received any part thereof, other than the credits given; *provided*, that no person or persons shall be compelled ^{Oath required}
to pay any tax or balance of taxes, so alleged to be unpaid, who shall before any justice of the peace in said county, make oath the said tax or balances of taxes has been paid and fully satisfied. Proviso
