CHAPTER 502.

Passed Mar. 6, 1850. *A supplement to an act entitled, an act to rebuild or repair the old Jail, in Allegany County.*

Commissioners to procure land and erect jail

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the commissioners, or a majority of them, named in the act to which this is a supplement, are hereby authorised and empowered to receive by donation or to purchase a lot or lots of ground, in the town of Cumberland, or the vicinity thereof, and to erect thereon a jail, the said lot of ground so given or purchased, to be conveyed to the said commissioners for the use of Allegany county, and the said commissioners, or a majority of them, are hereby authorised to pay for the said lot or lots of ground, if the same shall be obtained by purchase, out of any monies which may come into their hands, for the purpose of building the said new jail.

Authority to levy

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the commissioners of Allegany county, be and they are hereby empowered and directed to impose annually on the assessable property of the said county, the sum of two thousand dollars, to be assessed together with an allowance to the collector, the same commission for collection, that he receives for collecting the other county levy, which sum so assessed, shall be collected by the collector of Allegany county, as other county taxes are collected, and when so collected, shall by the said collector be paid to the said commissioners appointed by this act, or a majority of them, to be applied by them towards erecting the said jail, which said sum of two thousand dollars, shall be annually imposed, by the said county commissioners, on the assessable property of the said county, to be assessed, collected, paid and applied as aforesaid, until the requisite amount of money be collected for the completion of the said jail; *provided*, the whole sum required shall not exceed six thousand dollars.

Commissioners may borrow money

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the said commissioners, or a majority of them, shall be and they are hereby empowered to borrow, from time to time, such
