CHAP. 515.

An act to make valid a mortgage from Emanuel Feeser, to David Feeser. Passed Mar. 8, 1850

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Declared valid That a mortgage from Emanuel Feeser, to David Feeser, bearing date on the twenty-ninth day of September, in the year eighteen hundred and forty-nine, and recorded in Liber J. S., number ten, folio one hundred and fifty two, one of the land record books of Carroll county, be and the same is hereby made as valid in law, as if the affidavit required by the act of December session, eighteen hundred and forty-six, chapter two hundred and seventy-one, had been made by the said David Feeser, the mortgagee therein named, at the time of the execution of said mortgage; provided, that the said David Feeser, shall provide within sixty days from the passage of this act, file with the clerk of Carroll county court for record, an affidavit, that the consideration set forth in said deed of mortgage, is true and bona fide, as therein set forth.

CHAPTER 515.

A further supplement to an act to incorporate Emmittsburg, in Frederick County, passed at December Session, eighteen hundred and twenty-four. Passed March 7, 1850

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, To purchase or build engine house, etc That the burgess and commissioners of the town of Emmittsburg, in Frederick county, be and they are hereby empowered in their discretion to purchase or build an engine house, and a fire engine and apparatus, for the use of the said town.
