Muchlhofer, Lawrence Messer, Andrew Reuter, Samuel Gager and others, of the city of Baltimore, have formed themselves into an association under the name and style of the Baltimore German Homestead Association; and whereas, the object of the said association is to encourage economy and frugality, whereby the memlers thereof may in an easy and secure manner accumulate a sum sufficient to build or purchase a domicil for their families-Therefore,

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the aforesaid members of said association, as well as those who hereafter, according to the constitution and bye-laws of said association shall become memhers thereof, be and they are hereby
