No. 26.

Resolution in favor of John L. Stansbury.

Passed Feb. 6, 1850.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the State, be and he is hereby authorised to pay John L. Stansbury, clerk to the commissioners of Baltimore county, or order, the sum of nine dollars, being the amount due him for copies of collector's bond, ordered and furnished the deputy attorney general, in cases where suit had been instituted for the recovery of State tax in said county.

Resolution in favor of the legal representatives of Arth- ridge Foggett.

Passed Feb. 6, 1850.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of Maryland pay out of any unappropriated funds, to the order of the legal representatives of Arthridge Foggett, the arrears of pension due her on the twentieth day of May, eighteen hundred and forty-nine; dated from the first of January, eighteen hundred and forty-nine, in pursuance of resolution number sixty-five, of December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-four.

Resolutions in relation to certain resolutions transmitted by the Governor of Vermont, on the subject of slavery.

Passed Feb. 9, 1850.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That we recognise it as our duty to treat with consideration and respect the resolutions of other States, expressing in calm and dignified terms their honest convictions of grave constitutional rights.
