Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of Maryland pay, out of any unappropriated funds, to the order of John S. E. Nutwell, a sum equal to the State tax upon twenty-five hundred dollars of merchandise, for eight years from eighteen hundred and forty-two to eighteen hundred and forty-nine, inclusive, the said tax not being properly chargeable.

Resolution in favor of Benjamin L. Gantt.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer pay to Benjamin L. Gantt, Sergeant-at-Arms of the House of Delegates, at December Session, eighteen hundred and forty-six, the sum of one hundred and thirty-six dollars, and ten cents, in full for balance due him for services rendered by order of said House, in the case of Judge Le Grand.
