Resolution in favor of Sellman Cox, and Securities.

Mar. 9, 1850.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the State pay to Sellman Cox, his securities, or their order, the sum of thirty-nine dollars and thirty-five cents, on account of money overpaid for State tax, eighteen hundred and forty-one, out of any unappropriated money in the treasury, if the Treasurer shall be satisfied that such sum is due.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the State pay Lawrence A. Dawson, or order, the sum of fifty-one dollars and thirty-three cents, for fees due him as auditor.
