 Judges of election to receive, count and return number of ballots cast, to clerks of county courts, &c., duty of clerks, etc. " 2  
 Returns when received by governor, to be counted by governor, chancellor and chief judge of court of appeals, etc., if it appear that a majority of legal voters are in favor of a convention, governor to issue a proclamation ordering election to be held on 1st Wednesday in September, to frame a constitution, etc., if chancellor and chief judge refuse to act, governor alone to proceed to discharge the duties specified, etc. " 3  
 Number of delegates to be the same as each county and city of Baltimore have respectively, in both Houses of General Assembly, etc., Sheriff to give notice, etc. " 4  
 Convention to judge on validity of election, and qualification of members. " 5  
 Convention to meet on 1st Monday November 1850, their compensation and powers, etc. " 6
