## CHAPTER 32.

An act for the benefit of Thomas Miller, of Anne-Parsed Dec. 27, Arundel county.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Levy court to Maryland, That the levy court of Anne-Arundel county shall be, and they are hereby directed and empow-money for his maintenance. ered, at their levy court annually, to assess and levy on the assessable property of the said county, a sum of money not exceeding thirty dollars, for the support and maintenance of Thomas Miller, of said county; and that the same be collected annually, by the collector of Anne-Arundel county, and paid to such person as the levy court of said county shall or may direct.

An act to authorise and empower the Levy Court of Passed Dec. 27, Prince George's county, to assess and levy a sum of money for the purpose therein mentioned.

WHEREAS, Sarah Wright, of Prince George's Preamble, county, by her petition to this General Assembly hath et forth, that she is very poor, and far advanced in age, and from the numerous infirmities attendant on old age is rendered totally incapable of procuring a support by labour, and praying that a law may pass authorising the levy court of Prince George's county to assess and levy a sum of money for her support: Therefore,

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Levy court to Maryland, That the justices of the levy court of Prince money for her George's county be, and they are hereby authorised maintenance. and directed, to assess and levy on the assessable property of said county, a sum of money not exceeding thirty dollars, for the support and maintenance of the said Sarah Wright; and that the same be collected and paid annually, to the aforesaid Sarah Wright, or her order, by the collector of said county, agreeably to the order of the levy court aforesaid.
