## CHAPTER 60.

An act to authorise and empower the Levy Court of Passed Dec. 27, Anne-Arundel county to assess and levy a sum 1811. of money for the purpose therein mentioned.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of For the sup-Maryland, That the justices of the levy court of Shipley. Anne-Arundel county shall be, and they are hereby directed and empowered, at their levy court annually, to assess and levy on the assessable property of said county, a sum of money not exceeding thirty dollars, for the support and maintenance of Rebecca Shipley; and that the same be collected annually by the collector of Anne-Arundel county, and paid to the said Rebecca Shipley, or to her order.

## CHAPTER 61.

An act for the relief of John Hassard and Ralph Passed Dec. 27, Hassard, of the city of Baltimore.

WHEREAS, It has been represented to this Gen-Preamble. eral Assembly, that John Hassard and Ralph Hassard, of the city of Baltimore, having become, from losses in trade, unable to pay their debts, did heretofore apply to Baltimore county court for the benefit of the insolvent law passed at November session eighteen hundred and five, and its several supplements; And whereas, The said John Hassard and Ralph Hassard have also represented that the said county court hath in consequence of the said John and Ralph Hassard having neglected to give notice of their said application to certain of their creditors, who had assented to their release, adjudged that they are not entitled to the benefit of said act and supplements, notwithstanding the said John and Ralph Hassard have obtained the assent in writing of so many of their creditors as have due to them two thirds in amount, of the debts due by the said John Hassard and Ralph Hassard; whereby the said John Hassard and Ralph Hassard have lost the benefit of said act and its supplements; and it appearing to this General Assembly reasonable that the said John Hassard and Ralph Hassard should be relieved in the premises: Therefore,

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Benefits of in-Maryland, That the judges of Baltimore county court be, and they are hereby authorised and empowered to extend and afford to the said John Hassard and Ralph
