

Tilghman, one of the late Board of State's Agents, for the last year, one hundred dollars. For the salary of the Agricultural Chemist of this State, two thousand dollars. For the purchase of chemical implements and materials for the use of the Agricultural Chemist, fifty dollars. For the account of the State Tobacco Inspections in the city of Baltimore, twenty thousand dollars. CHAP. 120.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the Treasurer of this State, shall upon the warrant of the Comptroller of the treasury department, disburse the said sums of money hereinbefore appropriated, for the objects and purposes specified, to or upon the order of the person or persons, bodies politic or corporate severally entitled thereto, and that the several public officers to whom the same or any part thereof may be paid, shall render quarterly to the Comptroller, accounts of the expenditure thereof, with the proper vouchers therefor verified by affidavit, excepting such part thereof as may be disbursed out of the Executive contingent fund, upon the order of the Governor, and such further part thereof, as may be paid for and on account of salaries fixed by the Constitution or laws of this State. Treasurer upon warrant of Comptroller to disburse sums of money appropriated.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of the passage thereof. In force.

CHAPTER 120.

AN ACT to protect the official acts of A. Robertson Rogers, Commissioner under the act of eighteen hundred and thirty-seven, chapter ninety-seven, residing in the City of New York, against the loss of the oath taken and subscribed by him and filed pursuant to said act in the Executive Office of this State. Passed March 31, 1852.

WHEREAS, It appears from a certificate of Cornelius McLean, former Secretary of State, dated the third day of April, in the year eighteen hundred and forty, and from other satisfactory evidence, laid before us, that A.
