AN ACT to fix the Salaries of the Commissioners Passed April of Public Works.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Salary \$200 of Maryland, That the Commissioners of Public per annum. Works now elected, or hereafter to be elected or appointed, shall each during his term of service receive a salary at the rate of two hundred dollars per annum, to commence from the time he qualifies or has qualified by taking the oath prescribed by the fourth section of the first article of the constitution.
