SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That the bond of the Bond to be resaid agent, when duly executed and approved, as here-corded. inbefore provided, shall be recorded in the office of the clerk of the Court of Appeals, and certified copies thereof, under the seal of the said court, may be used in evidence in any court of law in this State, and shall have the same force and effect as if the original bond were produced and proved.
