SEC. 8. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Circuit court for Frederick county shall hold two terms annually, both for common law and equity proceedings, which said terms shall commence on the fourth Monday of February and on the second Monday of November respectively, in each and every year.
