## CHAPTER 150.

Passed April AN ACT for the relief of Andrew Hope of Harford 19, 1852.

## CHAPTER 151.

Passed April AN ACT relating to the Maryland Penitentiary, and appropriating a sum of money therein named.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the directors of the Maryland Penitentiary, or any two of them, be, and they are hereby authorised to draw on the Treasurer of the State of Maryland, for the sum of ten thousand dollars, to be expended by them in meeting the losses of that institution during the last fiscal year, and such as may have since occurred, and that the Treasurer hereby authorised to make this payment on the warrant of the Comptroller, so soon as this bill shall have passed and become a law.
