the business of may require, appler the bisiness of the news and such AN ACT to Incorporate the Town of Sharpsburgh Passed May and Miller's Addition to Sharpsburgh. 24, 1852.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Incorporated. of Maryland, That the citizens of the town of Sharpsburgh and Miller's addition to Sharpsburgh, in Washington county, shall be, and they are hereby constituted and made a body corporate, by the name of the burgess and commissioners of Sharpsburg, with all the privileges of a body corporate, and to have a common seal and perpetual succession.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the free white male Authority to citizens of Sharpsburgh and of Miller's addition to elect a bur-Sharpsburgh aforesaid, of the age of twenty one years burgess and and upwards, and having resided in the said town for five commisand during the space of six months next preceding the sioners. election, shall, on the first Wednesday in July next, be authorised to elect a burgess and assistant burgess and five commissioners for the said town, who shall have resided within the limits of said town six months next preceding the election.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That a justice of the peace for the time being, residing in said town, shall ap-peace to appoint by writing, under his hand and seal, one judge to judge to hold hold the first election who shall keep the polls open first election. from nipe o'clock in the morning until four o'clock in the evening, and shall conduct the said election in the manner in which judges of elections are now directed by law to conduct an election for Delegates to the General Assembly, as far as may be consistent with the provisions of this act, and the said judge shall make return, under his hand and seal, of the persons elected, to the clerk of Washington county, to be by him safe kept.

SEC. 4.
