Passed May AN ACT to authorise the Commissioners of Balti-5, 1852. more county to levy a sum of Money therein mentioned, to support the Public Schools of said county.

Authority to Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the commissioners of Baltimore county, are hereby authorised and directed to levy an additional sum of four cents on the hundred dollars, on the present assessable property of said county, to be collected under the same laws and in the same manner as other taxes are now, and shall hereafter be collected in said county, to be set apart and applied to the use of the public schools of said county, under the direction of the school commissioners thereof, and shall be applied to no other use or purpose whatever.

When to take Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the provisions of this act shall be carried into effect by the commissioners of Baltimore county, at the time of making the county levy for eighteen hundred and fifty-two.

SEC. 3.
