SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the assistant shall receive the annual salary of one thousand dollars, to be paid as salaries of other civil officers now are, or may be paid; and that for the expenses of said laboratory, the State Chemist shall be allowed the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars, to be annually paid in advance.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That all acts or parts of acts contrary to this act, be, and the same are hereby repealed.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall be in force from and after its passage, and shall continue in force until the first day of January, eighteen hundred and fifty-four, and until the end of the next session of the General Assembly that shall commence thereafter, unless sooner repealed by the Legislature.

Authority to
levy.

AN ACT to provide for the Compensation of the Crier to the Circuit Court of Prince George's County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That so much of the fourth section of the act of eighteen hundred and forty-two chapter one hundred and eighty-eight, which enacts "that the bailiffs and crier of Prince George's County Court and Courts of Equity, shall receive the same pay and allowance for travelling, which are by this act to jurors, &c.," be, and the same is hereby repealed, so far as it refers to the crier of the Circuit Court of Prince George's county.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That the county commissioners of Prince George's county, shall, at their levy laying term, in the year eighteen hundred and fifty-three, and at the same time in every succeeding year, levy on the assessable property of the county, the sum of eighty dollars, which shall be paid to the crier of said court, in lieu of the pay and allowance provided for in the act above referred to.
